2011 HIGHLIGHTS

- 1) Owners and Breeders Bonuses for all Overnight Races**
 - A bonus for Owners and Breeders of horses that were foaled in Alberta and placed third (3rd) or better in a race on tracks in Alberta.
- 2) Owners and Breeders Bonuses for all Stakes Races of \$7,000 and over**
 - Owners and Breeders of foaled in Alberta horses will receive a bonus for 1st, 2nd and 3rd for stakes races of \$10,000 and over on tracks in Alberta
 - 1st - \$550, 2nd - \$350, 3rd - \$250
- 3) Stallion Owner Bonuses**
 - A bonus will be paid out for Stallion Owners of horses foaled in Alberta for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in all races (Based on dollars earned by progeny)
 - Stallions must stand in Alberta

In order to be eligible to compete for "Foaled in Alberta" prize money, incentives, bonuses or awards, **horses must be accredited as Alberta Breds by the AQHRA**. Merely having "Alberta" as the location foaled on a horse registration certificate is not sufficient to ensure participation in Alberta Bred programs.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The highest bidder is to be the buyer. If a dispute arises between two or more bidders, sole authority to settle the dispute is reserved by the auctioneer. The auctioneer reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
2. Terms of the sale are cash, or personal cheques (with proper identification only) - NO EXCEPTIONS
3. **All yearlings are subject to a 6% sales commission whether sold or unsold on final bid price.**
4. As each horse is sold, an "ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF PURCHASE" will be handed to the buyer for signature. Please write clearly, giving a full name and address. Registration papers will be mailed to this address so it must be clear and accurate.
5. Horses become property of the buyer upon signing the "ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF PURCHASE" and the buyer assumes all risks and expenses of the horse from this time hence.
6. Upon receiving payment, the clerk will mark the "ACKNOWLEDGMENT" paid, whereupon it becomes your order to obtain delivery.
7. All horses are offered for sale according to the laws of the Province of Alberta, and the right to bid is reserved for all sellers in this sale unless otherwise announced (classified as a buyback).
8. All registration papers will be held by the Sales Management until all cheques are cleared. At such time they, along with the transfer certificates and fees, will be mailed to the AQHA for transfer, to the new owners. Transfer fees will be billed to the consignor as per AQHA's 2011 Rules and Regulations found under TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP (224 SECTION (2)).
9. The Sales Management and Auctioneers and employees act as agents for the seller but assumes no liability for either the buyer or seller. Any representation made by the Sales Management are made on behalf of the seller.
10. Every Effort has been made to ensure correctness of the catalogue, however, the AQHRA and the Auctioneer will assume no liability as to any statements, either written or verbal, regarding any horse sold, other than the information that was given "IN GOOD FAITH". All Yearlings of 2011 sold in this Sale are eligible to be nominated to the 2012 Canada Quarter Horse Cup Futurity and the 2013 Canada Quarter Horse Cup Derby, to be run in these respective years. **Please note:** To be eligible for the 2013 Canada Quarter Horse Cup Derby you must nominate your horse into the 2011 Canada Quarter Horse Cup Futurity.

You will no longer require a BERTH to nominate a horse into the 2012 Canada Quarter Horse Cup Futurity. Horses that PASS THROUGH the SALES RING will pay a total of \$600 to run in the 2012 Canada Quarter Horse Cup Futurity. NON-SALE Graduate horses will pay a total of \$1,800 to run in the Canada Quarter Horse Cup Futurity.
