

HORSEMEN

In 2019, Quarter Horse races will be hosted at two 'A' Track venues: Century Mile (Leduc) and Century Downs (Balzac). Owners must be licensed prior to entries.

'A' Tracks require that a horse(s) must have an official work if they have not raced in the last 45 days in order to enter.

Owners/trainers must enter directly with the Race Office at the hosting 'A' Track venue. Race conditions will be included in the EQUIBASE online condition book. [Equibase | Horsemen's Information](#)

CHECK REQUESTS Cleared purse monies will be release the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month upon request; otherwise all accounts will be cleared at the end of the racetrack's meet. [Check Request Form](#)

'A' Track Lasix

Quarter Horses are eligible to run on Lasix on the 'A' (major) circuit in Alberta.

Lasix Vouchers are to be prepaid to the AQHRA office in order to receive Lasix on race day.

[Lasix Certification/Decertification](#) forms must be submitted prior to entry and be approved by the Official Veterinarian for Horse Racing Alberta.

RACE ENTRY AT CENTURY MILE | Racing Office 780-660-1017

- TOE (Time of Entry) Payments are to be made directly to the AQHRA prior to entry with the Century Mile Race Office
- Original Papers must be filed at the race office by race day accompanied by a valid NEGATIVE COGGINS certificate
- If owners/trainers have silks, please bring them to race
- To arrange for location of Stalls
- Horses shipping in to race must be on the grounds by 7:00am on the day of the race for vet check. A copy of the coggins certificate is required to gain access to the grounds.

RACE ENTRY AT CENTURY DOWNS | Racing Office 587-349-7795

- TOE (Time of Entry) Payments are to be made directly to the AQHRA prior to entry with the Century Downs Race Office
- Original Papers must be filed at the race office by race day accompanied by a valid NEGATIVE COGGINS certificate
- If owners/trainers have silks, please bring them to race
- To arrange for location of Stalls
- Horses shipping in to race must be on the grounds by 7:00am on the day of the race for vet check.
